Enter number of the recipient to complete the transfer

Tap the Save icon to save the information 7. Tap the ✖ icon to delete a contact from the directory 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tap the More icon during an active call 2. Tap the Confnc icon 3. Enter the number of second participant 4. Tap the Confnc icon once the participant answers 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <p style="text-align: center;">To Add a Buddy</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select a speed dial contact from the Contact Directory 2. Tap the Edit icon 3. Navigate to Watch Buddy 4. Tap the Enable icon 5. Tap the Save icon <p style="text-align: center;">To Call from the Buddy List</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tap the More icon then the Buddies icon 2. Select a buddy 3. Tap the Dial icon to initiate the call 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tap the End Call icon to terminate your participation on the call 2. Have all callers hang up to terminate the entire conference call 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tap the Messages button <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Tap the New Call icon and dial *123 3. Enter the default pin (4-digit extension) 4. Reset pin <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. 4 - 15 digits b. Non sequential c. Non repetitive digits 5. Follow menu prompts 6. Tap the Messages button to access voicemail when alerted of a new message
